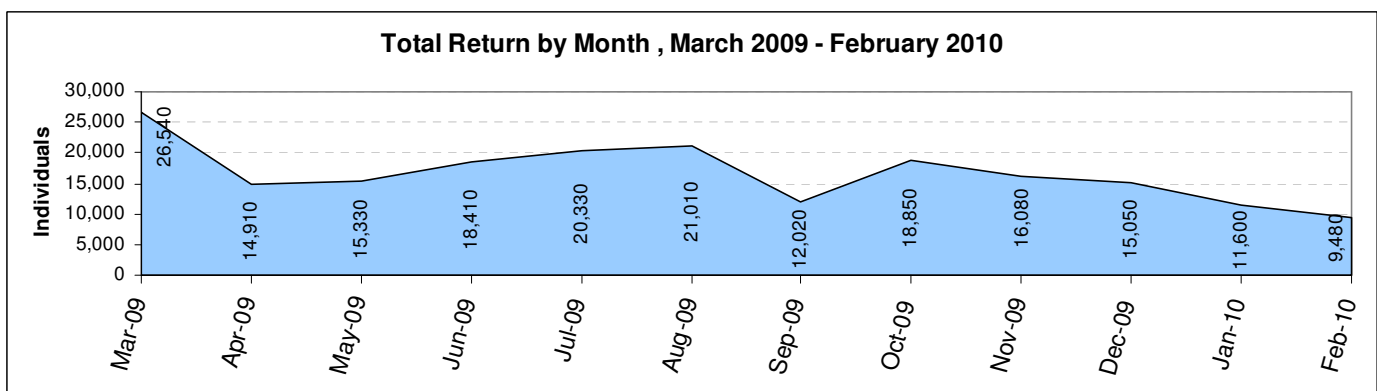
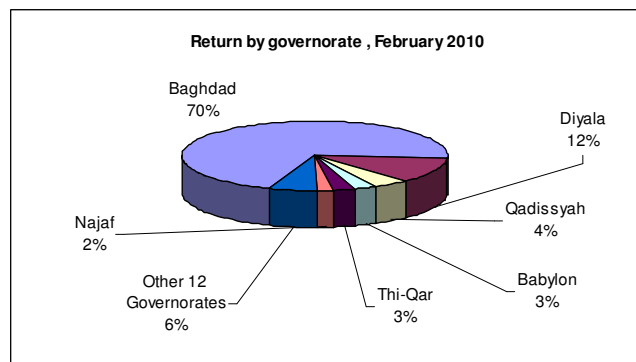
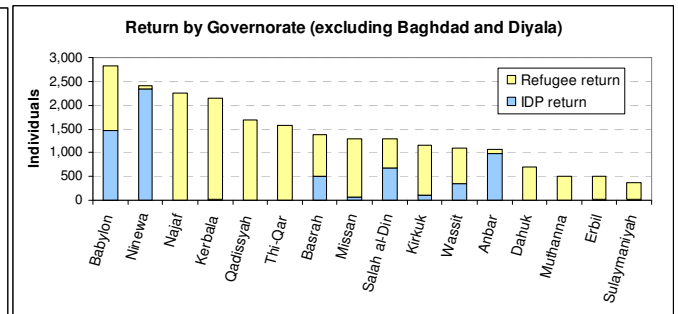
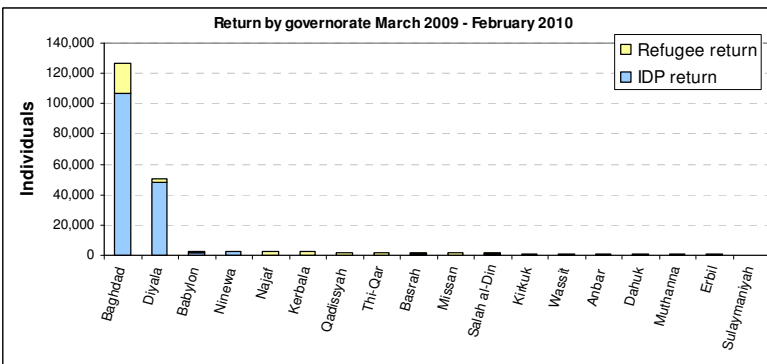


2. Returns (Refugees and IDPs) March 2009 – February 2010

In order to complement the repatriation data provided by its offices in neighboring countries and to systematically collect data on IDP returns, UNHCR started to collect refugee and IDP return data inside Iraq in July 2008. Data is collected on a monthly basis by UNHCR field offices Iraq who work in close coordination with MoDM, DDM, City Councils, and UNHCR Protection and Assistance Centres in all Governorates.

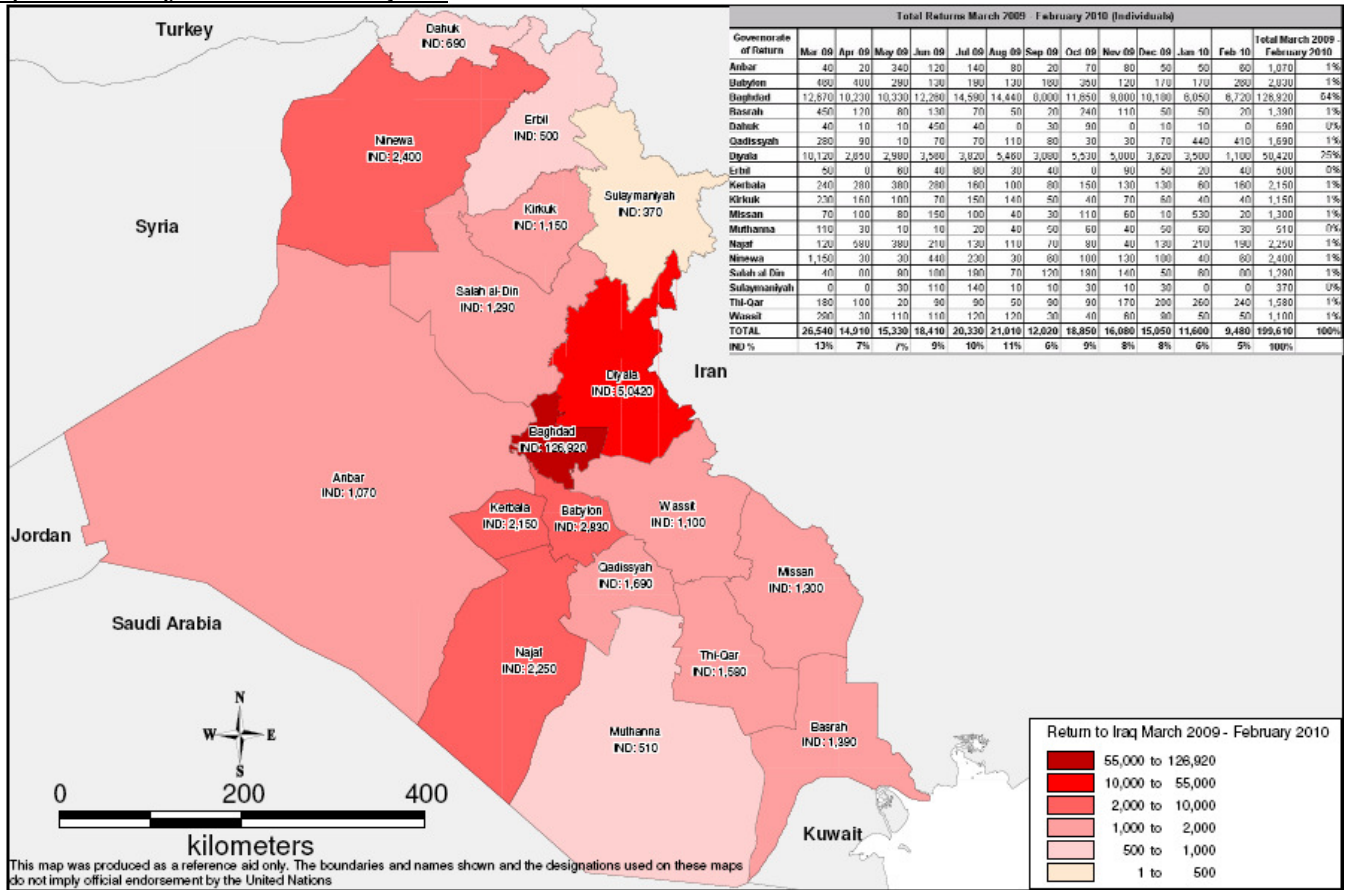

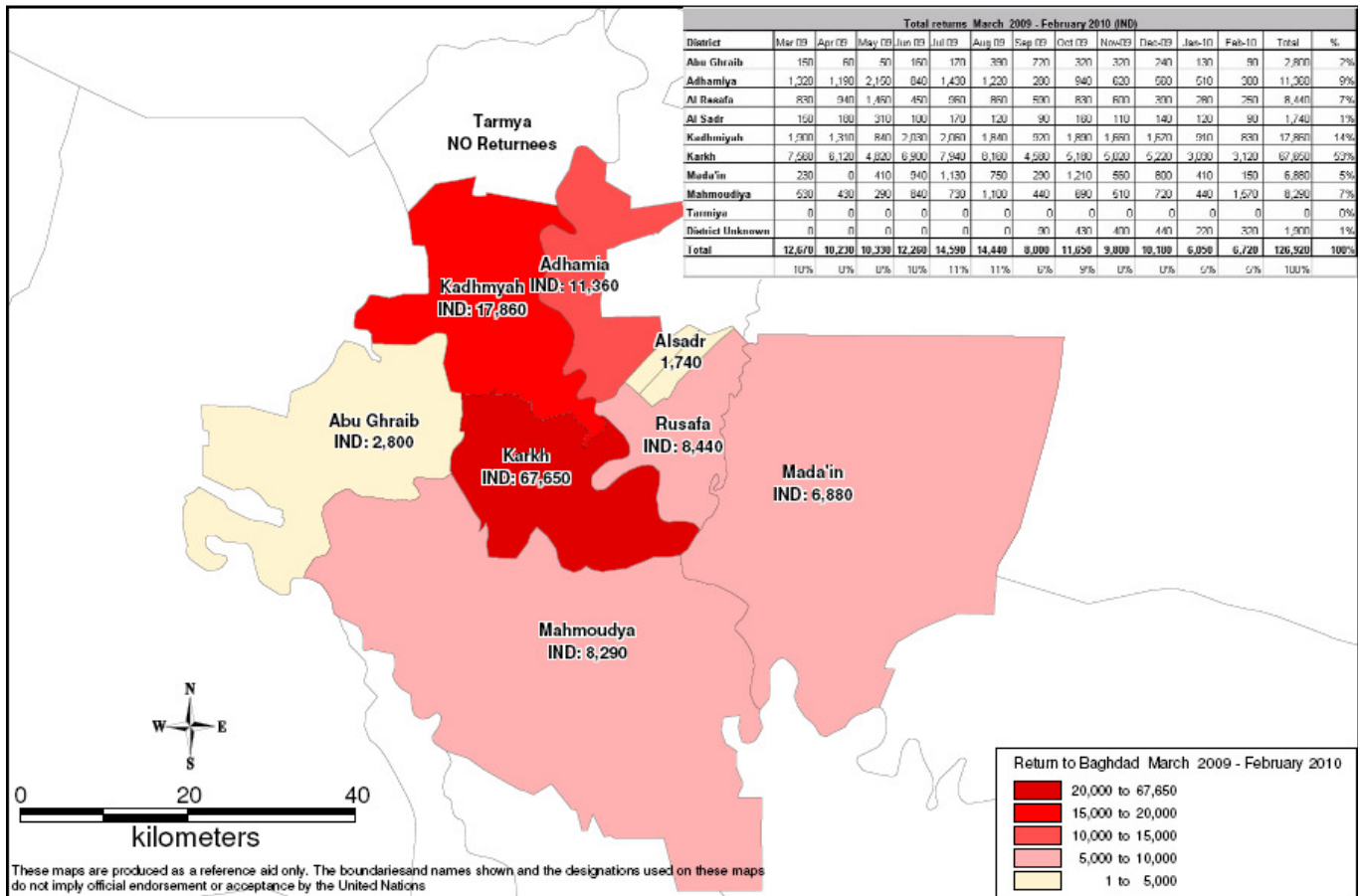

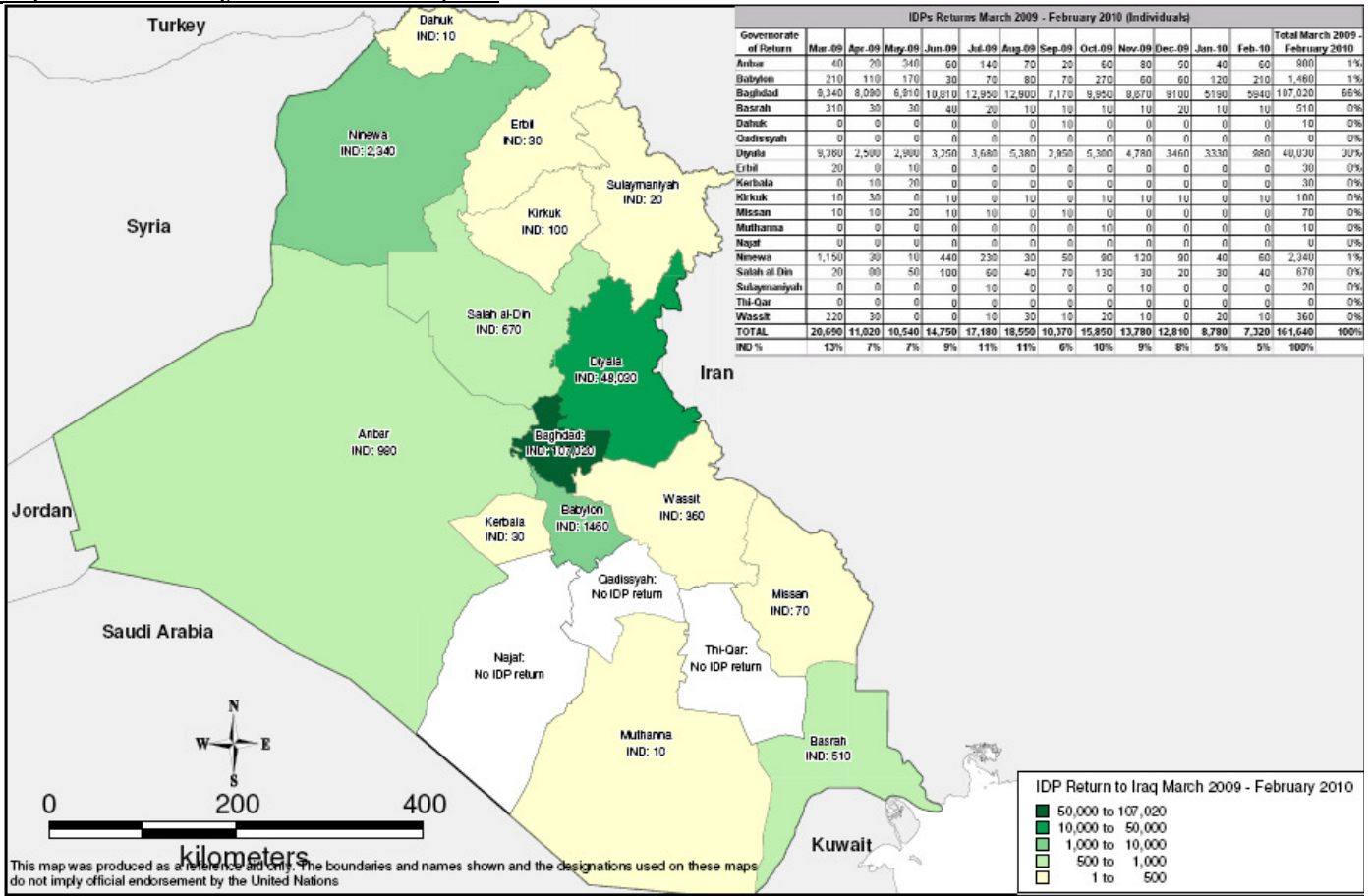
6. Map: Return to Iraq, March 2009 – February 2010



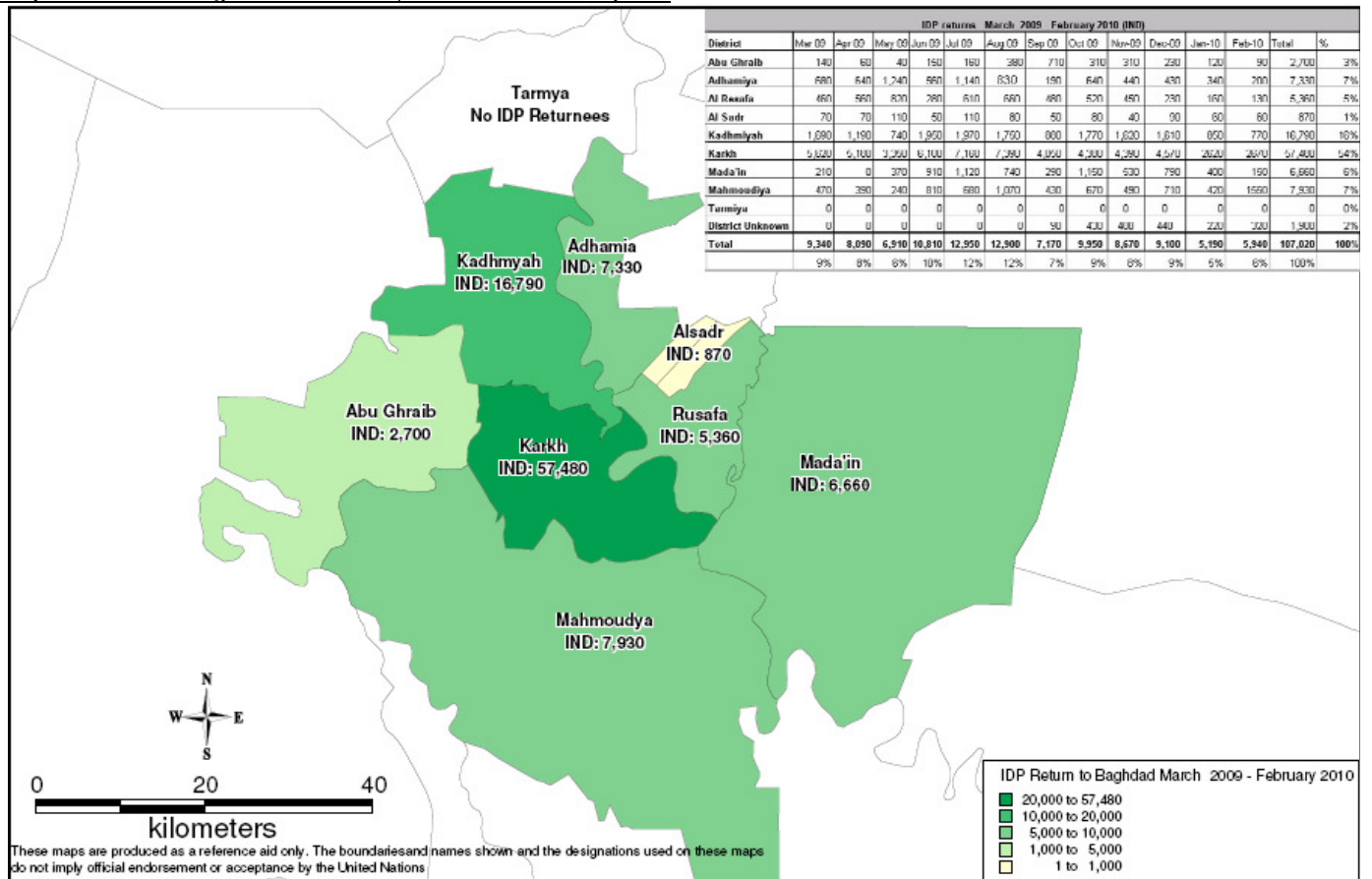
7. Map: Return to Baghdad, March 2009 – February 2010



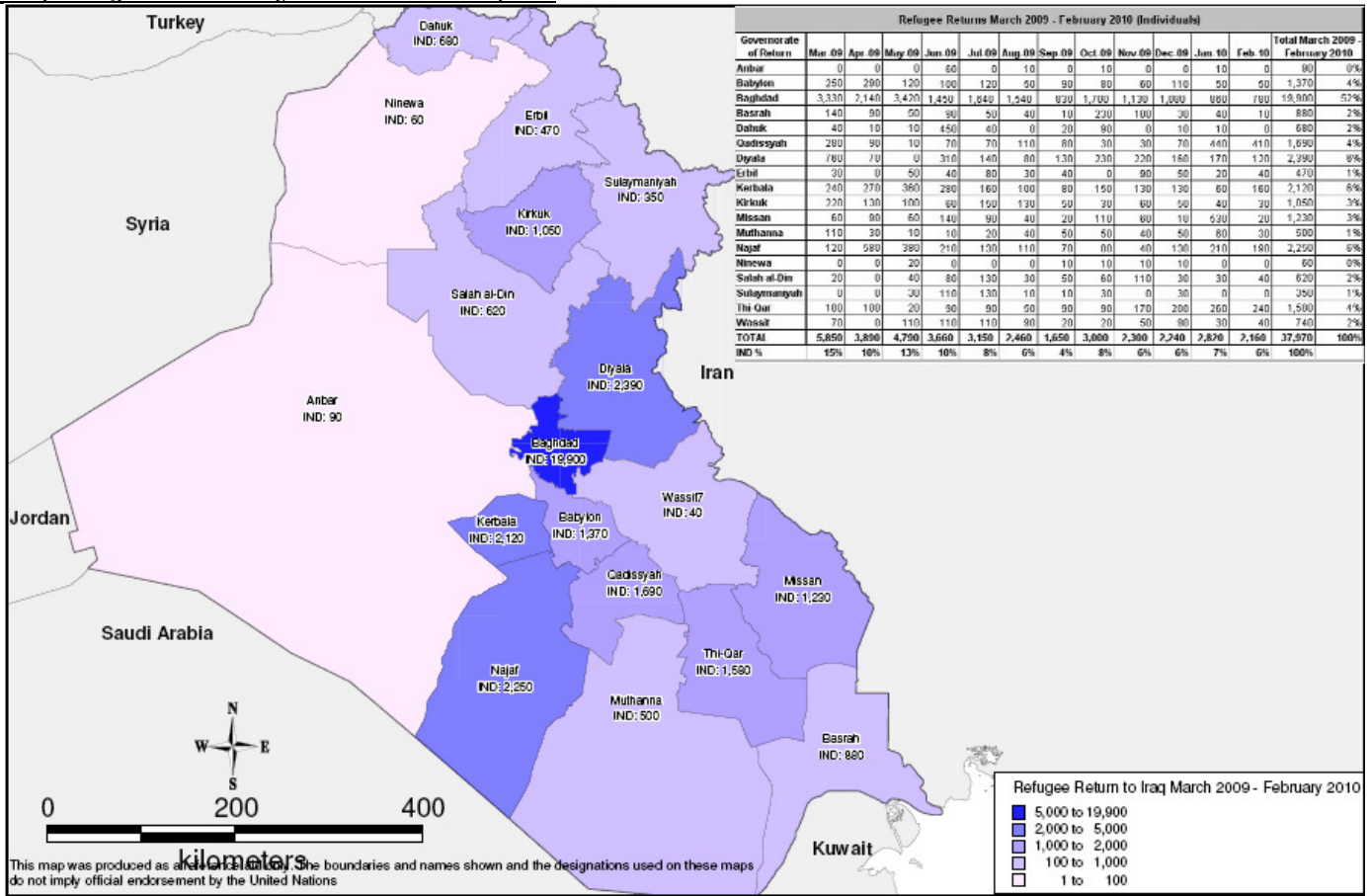
8. Map: IDP Return to Iraq, March 2009 – February 2010
